Students have participated in this Campaign through which the knowledge of the culture, language, Literature, tradition, practices of Orissa state with which we have been teamed, is explained and described. As a result students are getting to know, respect and acknowledge the similarities and differences, with the paired state i.e. Orissa. This promotes the values of equality, unity and national Integration.
